IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Camp Check-Out 10:00 AM On Sunday

CABINS:

We will be staying in cabins that have heating and AC. Cabins have bathrooms and showers inside. Bethel's will likely be combined in the cabins. These are bunk-style beds. Adult males will be roomed separately.

Park Entrance Fee:

Entrance into the park requires that cars, trucks, and motorcycles pay an entrance fee of \$7 per vehicle for in-state plates and \$9 per vehicle for out-of-state plates. They do provide pass-outs.

Registration:

The price of \$50 per overnight camper and \$25 per day camper is required at registration. There is an additional \$25 fee per camper (day or night) for late registrations. All Job's Daughters members and children must have a completed medical form (adults and daughters) included with their registration. Missing payment or medical form will result in the individual not being registered.

Overnight Campers:

Check-in for Friday starts at 7:00 PM. Check-out is anytime before 10:00 AM on Sunday. Costs include 4 meals and 2 snacks.

Day Campers:

Check-in for Saturday-only campers is 9:00 AM. Check-out is anytime before 10:00 PM that day. Day camper costs include lunch, dinner, and an evening snack.

Camp Expectations:

All daughters and children must have an adult chaperone at all times. This includes running back to your cabin to grab something. There will be no buddy system this year. Every daughter needs a CAV adult chaperone to walk with her. It is expected that the CAV to daughter/child ratio be at least 5:1.

The campgrounds do not allow any pets in the cabins or buildings. No alcoholic beverages are allowed at camp. Tobacco usage or vaping is prohibited in the buildings and within 100 feet of building entrances. Use of or possession of tobacco, controlled substances, or vapes by any person under the age of 20 is strictly prohibited. Daughters who violate these expectations will have their parents called to pick them up immediately. If an adult violates this rule, they will be sent home immediately.

These rules are being put in place to ensure everyone's safety.

Medical Expectations:

All individuals must be fever, vomit, and diarrhea-free for at least 24 hours without the help of medication before attending camp.

All campers should be free of communicable diseases and pests to attend.


