“WORLD OF YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP” PROGRAM GUIDELINES

PURPOSE: To encourage and promote academic scholarship(s) for the young women and young men in our Fraternal Youth Organizations as well as the members of the Order of the Eastern Star in Indiana.

PROGRAM PROCESS: Applications must be submitted before the deadline as determined by the Scholarship Awards Committee. The Scholarship Awards Committee will then meet to decide eligibility of the applicants and the amount of the awards based on funds available. Those selected for a scholarship award will be notified by mail to their address shown on the application and they will be announced at the Grand Chapter Session held in June.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must be a resident of Indiana, be a member in good standing and not have reached the age of majority of any of the following:

- An Assembly of the International Order of the Rainbow for Girls
- A Bethel of the International Order of Job’s Daughters
- A Chapter of DeMolay International
- A Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star

REQUIREMENTS:

1. The applicant must attend a school of higher learning such as a college, university, trade school, etc.
2. Submit a high school transcript (and college transcript if already in college) of grades.
3. Submit a list of extra-curricular activities.
4. Submit a list of awards and scholarships received.
5. Submit a list of community service performed and work experience.
6. Submit one letter of recommendation from a youth group counselor or Eastern Star Worthy Matron.
7. **TYPE OF AID:** Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis unless funds will permit otherwise. Repeat scholarships will be awarded only after all first-time applicants have been considered.

DEADLINE: April 25, 2023. Applications MUST be received by this date. (Recipients will be notified by mail in May and announced at Indiana Grand Chapter in June.)
