To the Daughters and Bethel Guardian Council:

It is with great excitement that we announce the 2026 "Dream Your Dream" Miss Indiana and Jr Miss Indiana Job's Daughters Pageant, which will be held Saturday, August 15, 2026 at the Eyrie Event Center in Plainfield, IN (115 W Main St Suite 250, Plainfield, IN 46168). The Pageant will begin at 6:30 pm.

All contestants must be active members in good standing in their Bethel, and must have completed their Proficiency Test. Miss Indiana contestants shall be at least sixteen (16) and not yet twenty (20) on the day of pageant. Jr Miss Contestants shall be at least ten (10) and not yet sixteen (16) on the day of pageant.

The Bethel Guardian must review the Indiana Pageant criteria found in the Indiana Manual of Rules and Regulations. Bethels must vote to approve a candidate to run for Pageant.

Pageant contestants are required to attend Pageant Preliminaries on Friday, August 7 at 7:30 pm at Northwest Lodge (5370 W 46th St, Indianapolis, IN 46254) for Pageant activities and a sleepover. The written test will be on Friday, August 7 and oral recitation on Saturday, August 8. On Saturday, August 15 at 9:00am at Mooresville Masonic Lodge (800 Indianapolis Rd, Mooresville, IN 46158) contestants will meet for the Interview and lunch with judges. Contestants will be released by 2:00pm to prepare for the Pageant. Contestants will need to be at the Eyrie Event Center at 5:30pm for a practice prior to the evening competition. There will be space reserved for final preparations for the contestants.

Registration fee is \$75 per contestant which is due with registration. In addition all contestants are required to raise Sponsor and Patron monies. The contestants are asked to obtain a minimum of \$300 in Sponsors and Patrons by August 7th. Bethel members, parents and other adults can help secure these donations. Remember, these donations defray the costs of Pageant, including our Miss Indiana competing in the Miss International Job's Daughters Pageant in Orlando, Florida in August 2027.

Sponsors and Patrons will have their names listed in the Pageant program. The contestant who raises the most money in sponsors and patrons will receive recognition at Pageant.

There will be a \$5 ticket charge for everyone attending the Pageant at the Eyrie. There will be a \$15 charge for those who would like to view the Pageant from home.

We are hoping to see at least one daughter from each Bethel represented at Pageant. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions.

Bethel Guardian's Checklist - 2026 Pageant

- Please encourage your daughters to participate in the pageant this year! Pageant is a wonderful experience and the girls make friends and memories to last a lifetime!! Preliminary events will be taking place on August 7-8, 2026. Interviews and Pageant will be on August 15, 2026.
- Read the communication (letter to daughters and council) at your soonest Bethel activity. Send the registration to packet out to any eligible daughters. Sign the eligibility form for each participating contestant.
- Check with the parents/guardians of each contestant and make sure they review the packet with their daughter. Make sure to remind them of the entry packet, the entry fee of \$75 due by July 15th. The required minimum Sponsor and Patron monies of \$300 due by the deadline of August 7th.
- Work with your contestant(s) to help them identify potential donors (sponsors and patrons) and be sure they are securing as many as possible.
- Miss contestants** will need to be prepared to give the opening and membership ceremony (minus examination of a member) for the Junior and Senior Princess. From the 2024 Ritual: Junior Princess pages 23, 44-46 and Senior Princess pages 24, 46, 48-49. Proficiency lesson work is required. 2026 Pageant Contestant Checklist

- Review the packet with your Bethel Guardian and have her sign the entry form, verifying you are eligible to participate.
- Complete the Contestant Entry Form and Contestant Questionnaire (plus a resume for Miss IN contestants) and mail them along with your entry fee of \$75 and the completed sheets by July 15, 2026 to Jamie Yeadon 5984 Lomita Ave Plainfield, IN 46168
- Immediately begin securing Sponsor and Patrons. Remember—a minimum of \$300 is required. The daughter raising the most money will receive an award at Pageant.
- Minimum \$300 sponsors/patrons donations is due by August 7, 2026.
- Miss contestants** will need to be prepared to give the opening and membership ceremony (minus examination of a member) for the Junior and Senior Princess. From the 2024 Ritual: Junior Princess pages 23, 44-46 and Senior Princess pages 24, 46, 48-49. Proficiency lesson work is required. Each Miss Contestant will draw for their part (either Junior Princess or Senior Princess). They should prepare for their written examination by studying the Ritual, Proficiency Lessons, Music Ritual and Constitution and Bylaws.
- Jr. Miss Contestants** will need to be prepared to give the 1st or 3rd Messenger membership ceremony. This can be found in the 2024 Ritual: 1M page 44 and 3M page 47. They should prepare for the written examination by studying the Ritual, Music Ritual and the Proficiency Lessons. Each contestant will draw for which messenger part they will recite.
- Ensure that your official regalia is perfect. The cord must be sewn on, with a four to six inch opening in the front, four inch hem, and three inches from the floor. Your robe should be clean and pressed and be sure you have white shoes, white hose and a full white slip or a long half slip and camisole. Press your headband and remember you need bobby pins.
- On August 15th, you will have a personal interview with our pageant judges who will also be judging the evening portion of the pageant. They want you to be successful. Do not be intimidated and be yourself.
- The dress code for Pageant weekend will be appropriate dresses, skirts and tops or business suits.
- Remember our organization is about grace and humility. Please remember this when selecting your gown for Pageant. Please review the dress code included in this packet before you select your gown. Remember every point counts and you do not want to be counted off for inappropriate dress.
- To prepare for the interview portion of competition, you may want to engage in conversations with other adults and have them interview you.
- To prepare for the Pageant stage presentation, you should practice walking in your gown and shoes, holding your head upright, smiling and maintaining good posture.
